

Rehearsal Checklist:

When scheduling your rehearsal it is important to make sure your wedding party knows the following information:

-They must attend!!!!

Once your ushers have seated all of your guests and you have determined that it is time to begin, we recommend that the wedding processional music begin (whether it is a cd or live music)

Your groomsman will usher in the following order:

Grandparents of the Groom

Grandparents of the Bride

Parents of the Groom

Parents of the Bride

Groom and Person performing the ceremony walk down the aisle.

1st groomsman/ bridesmaid

2nd groomsman/bridesmaid and so forth

Best Man/Maid of Honor

Flower girl/ring bearer

Father / Bride

If the grandparents cannot attend the rehearsal, it is important to let them know that they are a part of the ceremony, if you so choose.

It is important to make sure that the wedding party understands the importance of their attendance at your rehearsal. Being on time is also essential. It only takes about 30 minutes for a rehearsal and we give you one hour. Live music is always better than walking down the aisle to a cd. We can book an organist for you for \$100 if you do not have someone to play. We can also use our sound system and we have music for you to choose from if that is your wish.

If you must bring children to the rehearsal that is not in the wedding we ask that you also bring an adult to watch them. It is important for your wedding party to be able to concentrate on your wedding without distractions.
